Initial Enrollment Period (IEP)

If you are new to Medicare, you can enroll during your Initial Enrollment Period (IEP); the three months before, the month of, and the three months after your Part B effective date. Once you have been enrolled in a Medicare Plan, you can only make changes during the Annual Enrollment Period (AEP). Please be aware of the AEP dates are now October 15th to December 7th. This will give you a January 1st effective date for your new plan.

Annual Enrollment Period (AEP)

Applications must be signed and dated on, or between October 15th and December 7th. ***If they are signed prior to October 15th they will be returned to you with a new application.*** If they are received after December 7th, you will not be able to change plans until the next AEP for January of the following year.

Special Enrollment Period (SEP)

There are a number of reasons for Special Enrollments; Loss of a job that provides benefits, death of a spouse who's plan provided benefits, moving to an area where your old plan is not available, etc...

Our service area includes the following counties in Washington: Spokane.

Asuris TruAdvantage + Rx Classic (PPO), **Asuris TruAdvantage + Rx Enhanced (PPO)** and **Asuris TruAdvantage Basic (PPO)** have a network of doctors, hospitals, pharmacies, and other providers. If you use the providers that are not in our network, you may pay more for these services.

Out-of-network/non-contracted providers are under no obligation to treat Asuris Northwest Health members, except in emergency situations. If you receive care from an out-of-network/non-contracted provider, we will pay for the same services we cover in-network, as long as the services are medically necessary. For a decision about whether we will cover an out-of-network service, you or your provider can ask us for a pre-service organization determination before you receive the service. Please call our customer service number or see Chapter 4, section 1 of your Evidence of Coverage for more information, including the cost-sharing that applies to out-of-network services.

Asuris TruAdvantage + Rx Classic and **Asuris TruAdvantage + Rx Enhanced** cover Part D drugs. In addition, we cover Part B drugs such as chemotherapy and some drugs administered by your provider.

Asuris TruAdvantage Basic covers Part B drugs such as chemotherapy and some drugs administered by your provider.
